

Assistant/Associate Clinical Professor - Applied Behavior Analysis #605943

The Department of Educational Specialties (ESP) is seeking to fill a position at the Assistant/Associate Clinical Professor level with expertise in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) to start in August 2022. The position is a 9-month non-tenure track faculty line with the opportunity for summer teaching. Candidates need to demonstrate a commitment to excellence to teaching diverse students in higher education.

Responsibilities:

1. Teach online graduate classes in Applied Behavior Analysis and Positive Behavior Support in the VCS
2. Collaborate with other faculty in updating, revising, and delivering high-quality online coursework
3. Recruit and advise students in the PBS program while working collaboratively with university departments to promote the admission and matriculation of students
4. Fulfill service responsibilities to the department, college, university, and the profession
5. Assist with the development and implementation of goals and strategies related to the Positive Behavior Support Graduate Certificate program as delineated by ABAI and NAU policies and practices
6. Participate in the development and management of a quality assessment within the Positive Behavior Support Graduate Certificate
7. Collaborate with the VCS coordinator to maintain ABAI verification and explore ABAI accreditation

Minimum Qualifications:

Candidates for the Assistant Clinical Professor position **MUST** have:

1. An earned doctorate in Special Education, Psychology, Applied Behavior Analysis or related field from a regionally accredited institution. ABD candidates may be considered only if they will have their degree by the start date.
2. A current Board-Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) credential.
3. Demonstrated ability to integrate technology into teaching including experience with online delivery of higher education and associated support systems (can include college teaching as a graduate assistant).

Candidates for the Associate Clinical Professor position **MUST** have all the above, plus current status as associate professor or the equivalent of 6-years' experience as assistant professor.
